Windy City Broadband has increased its bandwidth capacity

Governor Dunleavy wants to expand the nation's stash of crude oil by adding a storage site on Adak

"It's an insurance policy," said Ott and estimates for starters, 100 tanks storing 100 million barrels of oil, could be installed at the former Adak Naval Air Facility.

Alaska Governor Mike Dunleavy has asked the U.S. Department of Energy to consider expanding the nation's emergency stash of crude oil by adding a storage site at the former military base on Adak Island. The governor by letter argues that an oil stockpile in the nation's westernmost community could reduce the risk of supply disruptions for America's Asian allies and West Coast markers.

With "geopolitical instability" in the Middle East and trade tensions with China, "the energy security of both our West Coast and our strategic

partners in the Pacific Rim is increasingly uncertain" Dunleavy wrote.

"The proposed Adak project would cut maritime delivery times from weeks to days" the governor wrote.

David Ott who was the logistics and infrastructure manager for Shell in Alaska has been working on the Adak idea with the governor's economic development team.

Ott pegs the project's cost at \$2.5 billion and would include upgrades to former military facilities including the port and the airport. Mead Treadwell, a former Alaska lieutenant governor and investor in Arctic projects, said he is not involved in the proposal but knows about it.

"It would upgrade infrastructure in the region as sea ice melts and Arctic shipping grows" he said.

"The idea is intriguing, Alaska should be looking for more revenue ideas to pay for the western ports we need in the newly accessible Arctic Ocean."

The Aleut Corp, the native corporation for the region has made no reply.
