

Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP)

The Affordable Connectivity Program is an FCC benefit program that helps ensure that households can afford the broadband they need for work, school, healthcare and more.

Adak is a qualifying Tribal land and eligible for \$75/month discount for eligible households. Check the box for Tribal Lands to receive the full maximum benefit. The benefit also provides a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers. The ACP program is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

To determine if your household is eligible and to apply, visit <u>GetInternet.gov</u> to apply or print out a mail-in application. Once USAC approves your application, contact Windy City Broadband at 1-800-328-4222 or dialing 611 from your landline or wireless phone to complete your enrollment.

Who is Eligible for the Affordable Connectivity Program?

Households can qualify by showing one member of their household meets one of the following criteria below:

- Participates in the FCC's Lifeline program
- Has household income at or below 200% of federal poverty limit
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) formerly known as Food stamps
- Medicaid
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
- Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit
- Received a Federal Pell Grant in the current award year
- Participates in free & reduced-price school lunch program or school breakfast program
- Participates in the Special Supplemental Nutritional Program for Woman, Infants and Children (WIC)
- Participates in one of these assistance programs and lives on Qualifying Tribal Lands:
- Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance
- Tribal TANF
- Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations
- Tribal head Start (income based)

After you apply, USAC will share the results with you. You may be requested for additional documentation and will be provided with information on how you can submit those documents for review.
